

## ADVISING NOTES FOR SPRING 2021

**Registration for Spring 2021 will begin on November 3, 2020.**

**Advising is now open** for the Spring 2021 semester. Please consult with your program director or campus director about courses in which to enroll (Dr. Johnson for SA campus, Dr. Ellis for any MDiv student, and Dr. Maurer for all MAFM students). Have a conversation with your advisor in plenty of time to enroll in the classes when registration for the Spring term opens on November 3.

The **course schedule for Spring 2021** is attached. We are still listing most course sections in terms of section A (Abilene students), section S (San Antonio students), and section V (interactive video from individual devices.) Enroll in the appropriate section for your location. However, nearly all the Spring 2021 classes will be conducted by interactive video due to the threat of COVID-19. Occasionally some classes may be able to meet for some sessions in person in Abilene or San Antonio. Consult with the professor of each class or campus director for details.

If you attempt to enroll in a **course section that is closed** (for example, an A, S, or V section), feel free to contact Mrs. Lori West to inquire if more seats in your section can be opened up in light of lower enrollment in other sections. Her contact info is below.

Usually it is obvious to students when courses on the schedule meet particular degree plan requirements. However, it may be helpful to know the following options for two courses in the Spring schedule with regard to their meeting **degree requirements**.

- The course *OT Exegesis: The Decalogue and Ethical Living* may be taken (1) as BIBL 6301 to meet an OT requirement, or (2) as THEO 5099 to meet an ethics requirement. Of course, either section can be taken as a general elective.
- The course *Cross-Cultural Leadership in Ministry* may be taken (1) as MISS 6099 to meet a missions requirement, or (2) as MNST 6099 to meet a ministry elective. Of course, either section can be taken as a general elective.
